

Connie Durham's "Communication Transformation System" Explained

On Monday October 5, 2020, Connie Durham captivated the Rotary Club of Sandy Springs by sharing elements of her "Communication Transformation System". One of the tools she uses to help others learn to communicate with confidence is the acronym, D.I.S.C.



The DISC system centers on four different personality traits which are Dominance (D), Influence (I), Steadiness (S), and Conscientiousness (C). Under each trait is a series of descriptive words designed to help a person recognize strengths and weaknesses within a group or team of people. Knowing how to use the DISC system can help determine a course of action when dealing with problems as with a leadership team. It helps by taking the various aspects of each type into account when solving problems or assigning jobs.
