- The annual Day of Hope event provides over 2,000 residents with a day of family fun as well as much needed food and health services.
- Over 1,500 pairs of tennis shoes are distributed to residents in need at the annual Day of Hope.
- Last year, Hope Roswell provided high school students with over \$2,000 in gift cards to assist in purchasing back to school supplies.
- Hope Roswell assists in bringing awareness to the community of the need for foster care and assists in finding and training new foster parents.
- Hope Roswell recently started a phonetics program to assist preschoolers in learning the alphabet, numbers, colors, and shapes.
