One of the most interesting aspects of this research is that it is the first time that a 3D scan of a person's face has been used to create a 3D model of their face. This is a significant achievement, as it allows researchers to study the face in a way that is not possible with traditional 2D images. The researchers used a 3D scanner to capture the face's geometry, and then used a software program to create a 3D model of the face. This model can be used to study the face's shape and structure, and to compare it to other faces. The researchers found that the 3D model of the face was more accurate than a 2D image, and that it could be used to identify a person's face with a higher degree of accuracy. This research has important implications for the study of face perception, and for the development of face recognition technology.




Veteran's Event
