U. S. Ambassador (RET.) Tod Sedgwick

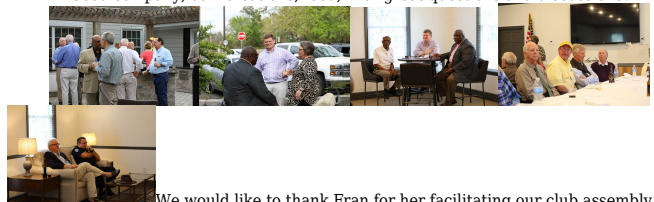
