

What if we had a vaccine to prevent cancer?

We can prevent >90% of HPV cancers through vaccination.



In 2012, there were 14.1 million new cases across the world. We expect there to be 21.7 million new cases globally by 2030.

HPV Causes Six Cancers



About 31,500 cases of HPVrelated cancers per year



Nearly 530,000 cases of cervical cancer per year
