Each club is generally eligible for a grant of about \$1700 - we have used this for a variety of projects - last year to help fund our holiday book project at Dresden and Kingsley In addition, there is a competitive grant available for up to \$10,000, Applications for both types of grants are due by May 15.

Some of us have held informal chats about serving the Alzheimer's victims and their families, perhaps through a Respite care at a local church.
