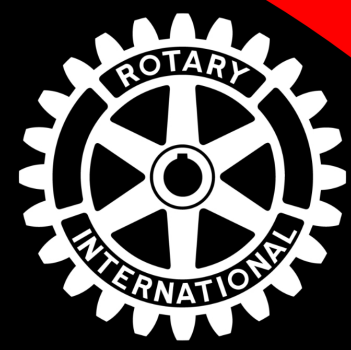

KNOW THE 12 SUICIDE WARNING SIGNS



- ▶ FEELING LIKE A BURDEN
- ▶ BEING ISOLATED
- ▶ INCREASED ANXIETY
- ▶ FEELING TRAPPED OR IN UNBEARABLE PAIN
- ▶ INCREASED SUBSTANCE USE
- ▶ LOOKING FOR A WAY TO ACCESS LETHAL MEANS
- ▶ INCREASED ANGER OR RAGE
- ▶ EXTREME MOOD SWING
- ▶ EXPRESS HOPELESSNESS
- ▶ SLEEPING TOO LITTLE OR TOO MUCH
- ▶ TALKING OR POSTING ABOUT WANTING TO DIE
- ▶ MAKING PLANS FOR SUICIDE

5 STEPS TO HELP SOMEONE AT RISK

- ▶ ASK
- ▶ KEEP THEM SAFE
- ▶ BE THERE
- ▶ HELP THEM CONNECT
- ▶ FOLLOW UP
