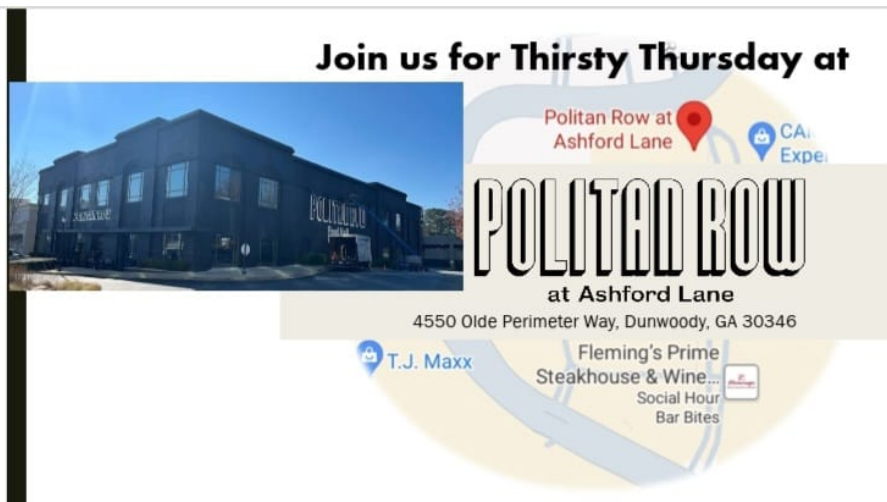




No Meeting This Friday or Next
