September: The Gathering Month!

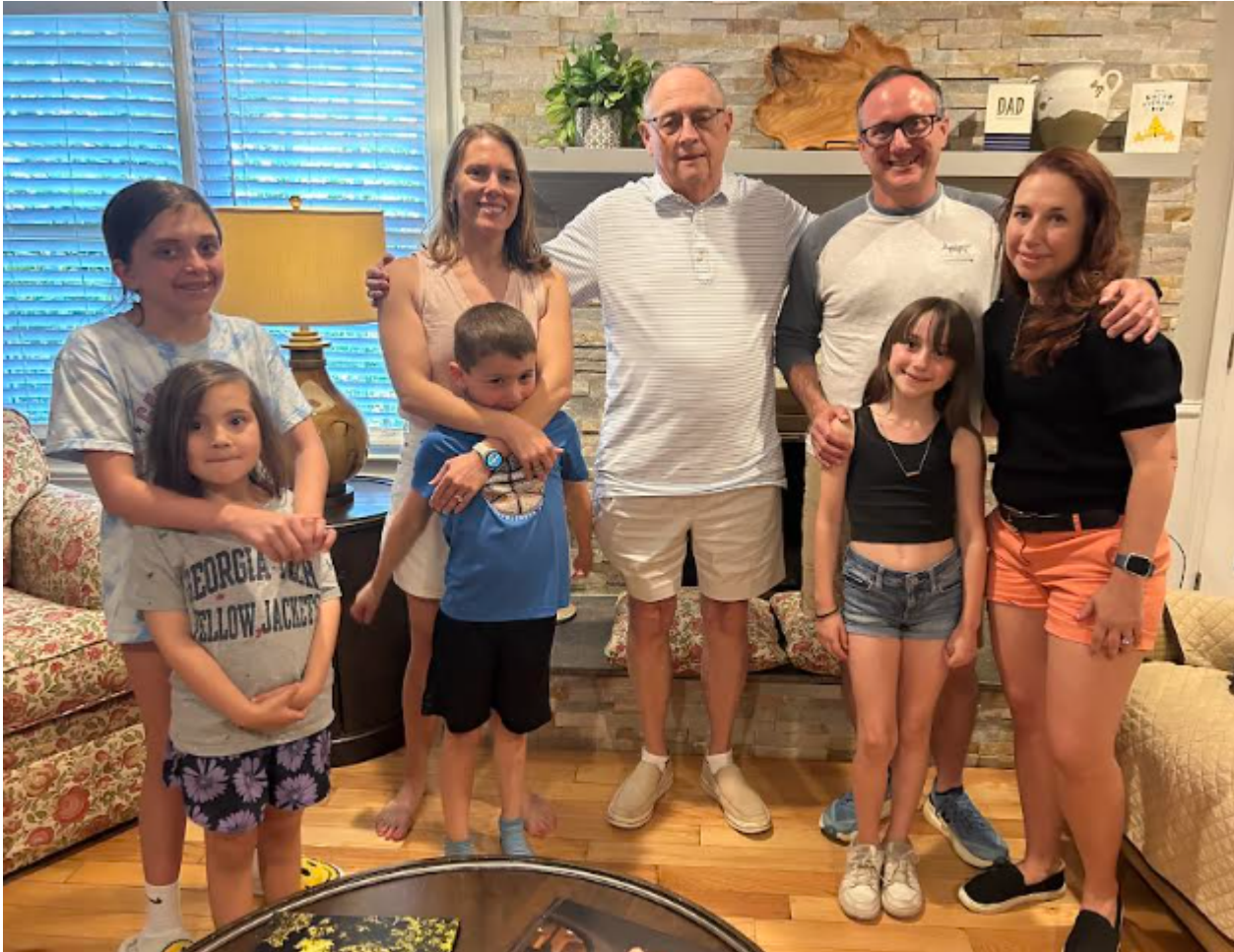
