The project was a first for our club and grew out of a casual conversation between Jason and owners of T'velo Brewing Co. Other downtown restaurants and bars quickly joined the effort. Supporters purchased \$10 wristbands to qualify for specials that benefitted Rotary's **End Polio Now** campaign. About 35% of wristbands sold for the event (\$706) came from community sales – helping the club exceed its annual campaign commitment of \$1,500.

Jason and Andre Marria made wristband sales a friendly competition – which Andre won. Andre sold about 60% of the wristbands, and she purchased 20 to distribute among people she knows.
