Last week I received 5 care packages from your club and I wanted to express the gratitude of my entire troop. Thank you all very much for taking the time and effort out of your day to put together those packages. I know that obtaining all of that stuff, packing it, and shipping international is no small task. All of the boxes made it to our location in great shape.

I can guarantee you that every single item sent was claimed by one of my soldiers within 5 minutes of opening them. Everything from the jump ropes to the toothpaste will be utilized.

Chaos Troop is a thirty man dismounted reconnaissance company that is part of the 2nd Brigade Combat Team, 101st Airborne Division. Right now we are playing an "advise and assist" role with the Iraqi Army 15th Division and helping them to retake Mosul from ISIS.
