


EARLY READING PROGRAM at WOODWARD ELEMENTARY



Almost 90% of children who are having trouble learning to read in kindergarten will still be having trouble in third grade.

The **Rotary Club of Brookhaven** and its partners have implemented a program to enroll Pre-K and Kindergarten students with their parents to receive books and resources provided by the Ferst Foundation for Early Childhood Literacy. All books will be distributed through the classroom to confirm families receive monthly book and parent reading guides.

IMPACT:

- Create a rich language environment where children learn through reading.
- Promote family involvement to achieve early school success for children.
- Encourage parents and caregivers to read every day with their children.
- Translate and distribute Spanish reading guides/newsletters for each book distributed.

2016 GOALS:

- Introduce books to each class monthly through volunteer reading sessions
- Distribute 792 books to 66 Pre-K student
- Distribute 2,184 books to 182 Kindergarten students
- Translate 24 parent reading guides to Spanish
