Assistant Governor for the Barnesville, Griffin, Jackson-Butts County, and Peachtree City Rotary clubs from 2012 - 2015, and was awarded the "FOLLOW ME" award by Rotary District 6900 as the Assistant Governor of the Year in 2012. He is a Paul Harris Society Member, Bequest Society Member and Major Donor.



Now that you have had time to acclimate to Rotary, I wanted to tell you about and encourage you to participate and contribute to the Georgia Rotary Student Program (GRSP). Help us continue this outstanding program which is exclusive in the Rotary world to Georgia. Our club is one of the biggest contributors to the program and we host a student each year. This year, we have Jad Tabet from Lebanon.

Georgia Student Rotary Program

The program started in 1946 with 4 students and a budget of \$4000. This year there are 51 students from 18 Countries studying in 24 Colleges and Universities and the GRSP budget this year is over \$1,300.000.00 and is funded exclusively by Georgia Rotarians.

Here in Georgia, the HOPE scholarship program has increased attendance at Colleges and Universities which is good BUT, it has allowed these institutions to increase their tuitions which makes it more expensive for the GRSP program.

However, with help from Rotarians like yourself, we can keep this program alive and well. If every Rotarian in Georgia would contribute "tax deductible" \$100.00 per year, everything would run smoothly. Please contribute the \$25.00 added to your quarterly invoice listed as voluntary.

Once you reach the \$1,000.00 level, you will become a WILL WATT FELLOW. We currently have just under 200 Will Watt fellows in our club.

Also, remember that we have a "matching funds" campaign where you can receive up to \$300 toward reaching a WILL WATT FELLOWSHIP. The club will match \$100.00, \$200.00 or any amount up to \$300.00. if you wish to pursue the fellowship quickly. And remember that your contributions are "tax deductible".

Rotary Global Grant Progress Report

More than a dozen Rotarians have committed 3 years and hundreds of hours to bringing hope to Honduras through a Global Grant. The Roswell Rotary Club in partnership with the Villa Real De Tegucigalpa Rotary Club in Honduras was awarded a Global Grant in the amount of \$73,225. The objective of this grant is to provide a potable water system to approximately 1,900 people (380 families) in the communities of El Resbaloso and Piedras Blancas in the Goascoran municipality located in rural southern Honduras.

5. **Nov 3** - Roswell Rotary hosts your Interact Clubs, liaisons and school leadership. Awards will be passed out.


