

## Honoring our Veterans Don Howard US Army - 1967-1971

Don enlisted in the Army in September 1967 and was assigned to Fort Jackson, S.C. for basic training. He was then in Fort Devins, Mass. for advanced training as a Morse Code Intercept Operator for the Army Security Agency. After graduation he arrived in Viet Nam in July 1968 for the first of three tours that ended in September 1970. During his tours of duty in Viet Nam, he was assigned to the 138th Avn Co in Phu Bai and DaNang. He flew over 350 missions as a radio operator in a fixed wing aircraft (U-8's and U-10's) which equals over 1500 hours. There was a stretch where Don flew 68 consecutive days. Don returned to the States in September 1970 and was stationed at Fort Bliss in El Paso, Texas. He was honorably discharged in September 1971.

Fulton County residents have identified transportation and congestion relief as one of the most important issues facing Metro Atlanta. The Fulton County Transportation Special Purpose Local Option Sales Tax (TSPLOST) is proposed for a 0.75% (3/4 of a penny) sales tax to raise an estimated \$655 million over 5 years and is on the November 8, 2016 ballot for a vote. Come hear from Mayor Wood and city staff how the proposed TSPLOST will address transportation improvements in Roswell.
