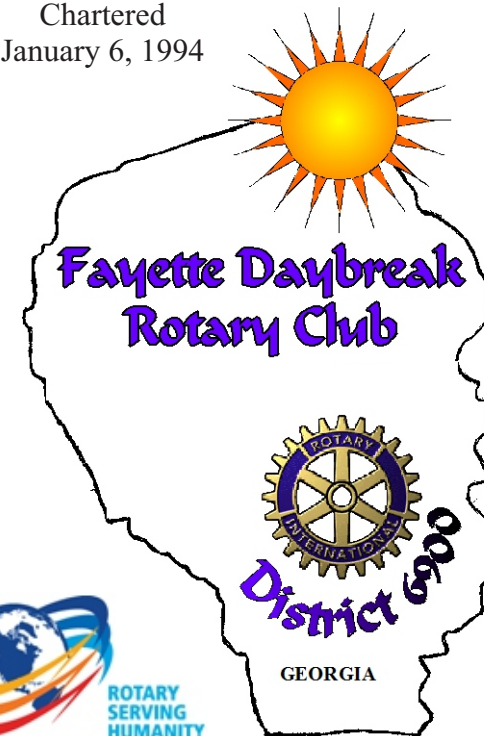

We will be working with AFM in collecting needed items for our Veterans and their families during the Holiday Season. More information next week.

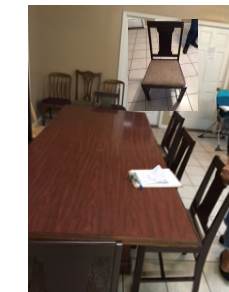

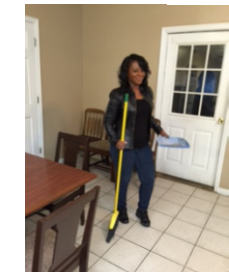

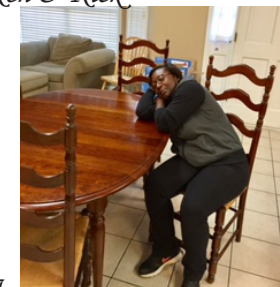
