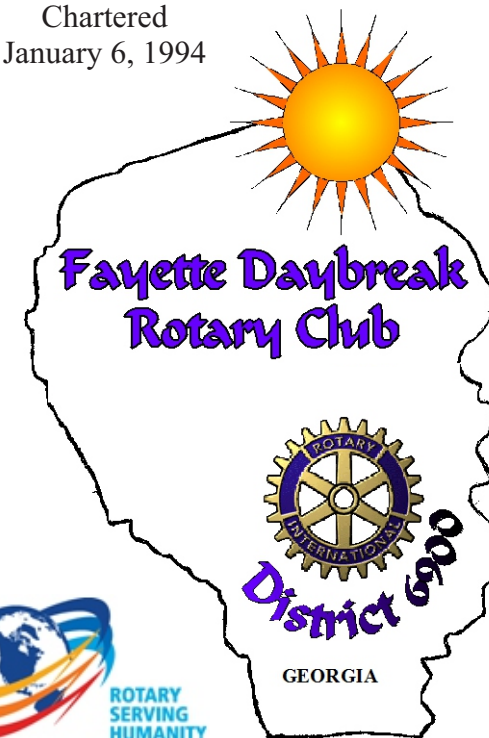

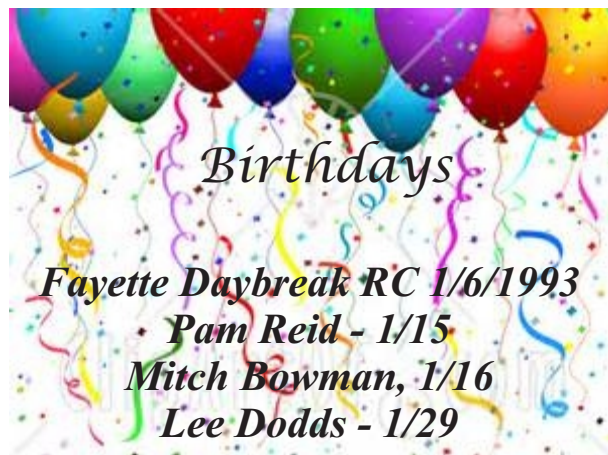

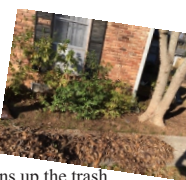
This pasted Saturday, 1/14 club members came out
