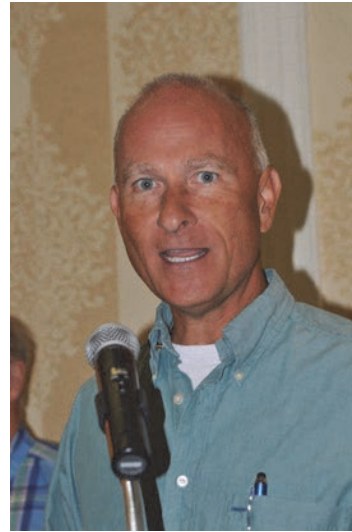

President Keith Funderburk presided over the meeting and gave sunshine for a family trip to Alaska coming this week.



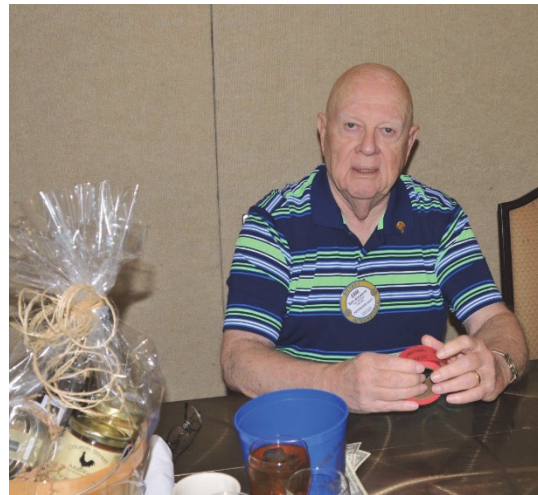
Past President Jim Bunda conducted the invocation and led the club in the Pledge of Allegiance and Four Way Test.



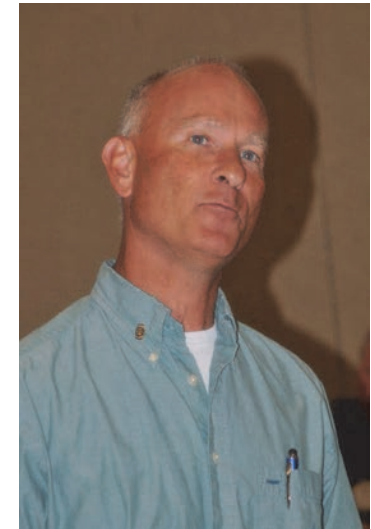
Bennett Frye won a gift basket from Church Street Market in the Carithers Scholarship raffle.
