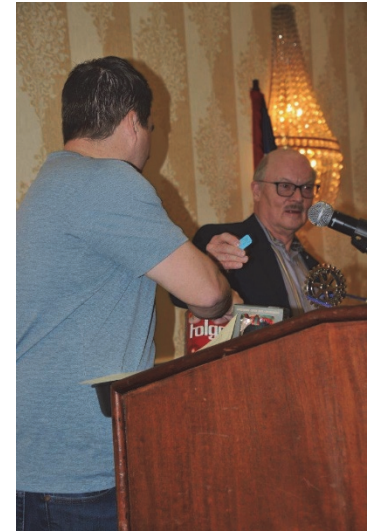
**December 16 Meeting

**Past President Mike White** gave sunshine for being alive another day.



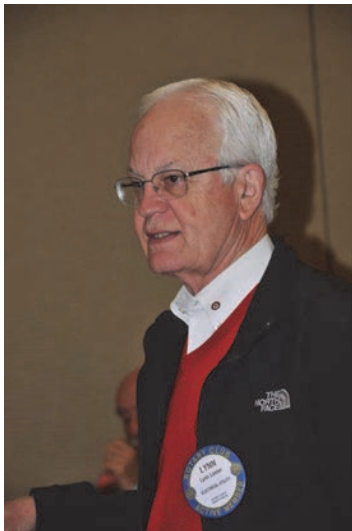
**PDG Robert Hall** gave sunshine for his grandson's high school graduation.



**Jason Marbutt** gave an update on the club's Dictionary project.



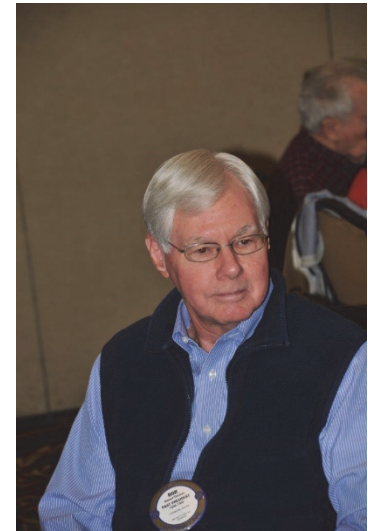
**President-elect Mitch Simmons** spoke about the 2020 District Conference.

**Mark Bigelow** was recognized for leading a successful flooring project for the CCYA.



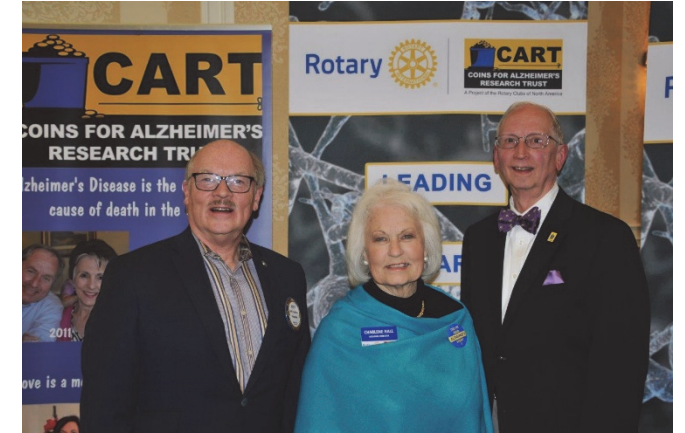
