incoming President and the exchange of the Presidential Jewel which was given to our Club by the Blackburn England Club. Gardner also thanked outgoing President Janice Wallace for her service as President and presented her with a plaque, the traditional Past President lapel pen, and a gift certificate. Both Janice and Tom were recognized with standing ovations.
