**Steve McNeel** won a bottle of wine in the Carithers Scholarship raffle.

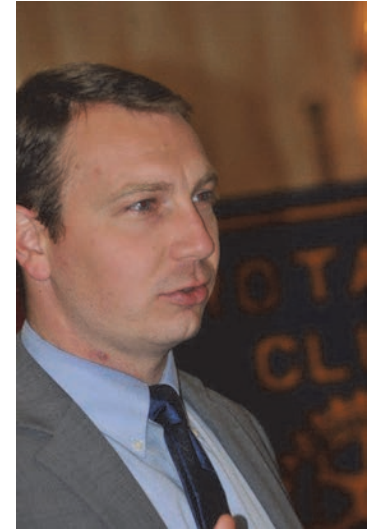




**President Jim Bunda** won a bottle of champagne in the Carithers Scholarship raffle.

**Chris Stokes** asked for volunteers for the club's dictionary literacy project.



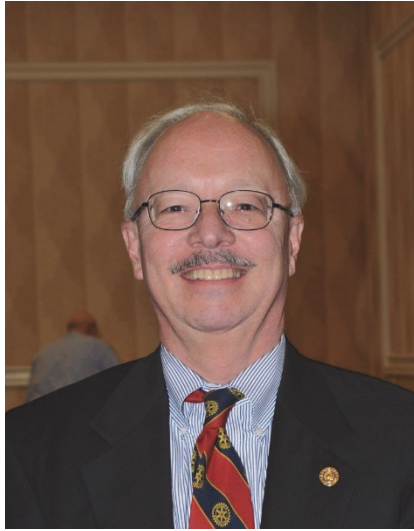
**Amy Erskine** passed out sign-up sheets for the club's holiday party and the Cobb Christmas and Ronald McDonald House service projects.

**Executive Director Kim Borna** of the Center for Children and Young Adults shared a book with the club being sold for a fundraiser.

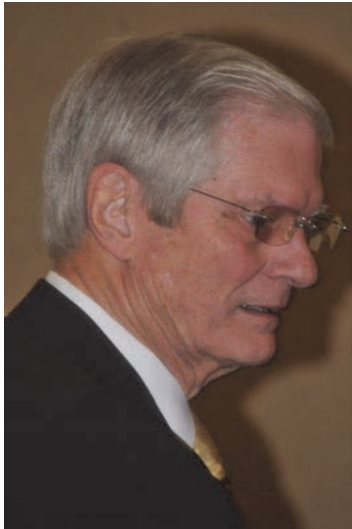




**Past President Roger Rozen** gave sunshine for his daughter **Jenny** who gave birth to his granddaughter on November 4<sup>th</sup>.
