**Past President Jim Boone** conducted the invocation and led the club in the Pledge of Allegiance and Four Way Test.



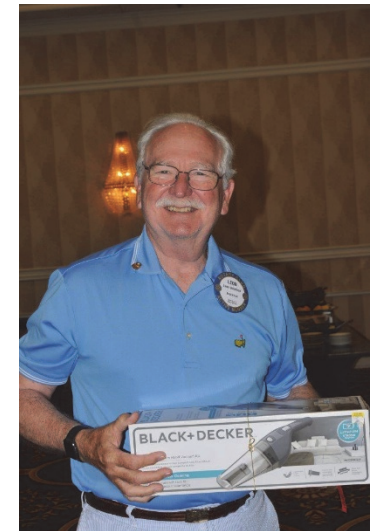
**Joey Ward** selected the winning raffle ticket.

**President-elect Keith Funderburk** gave sunshine for the District Conference and a chance to visit with his grandchildren while there.



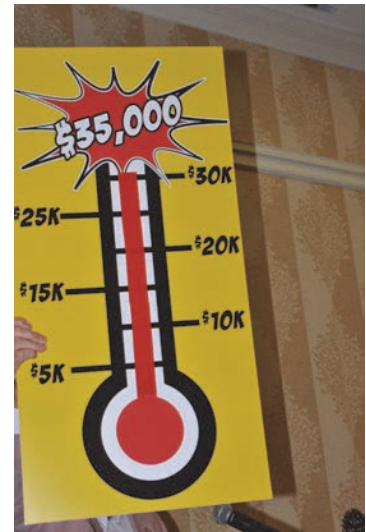

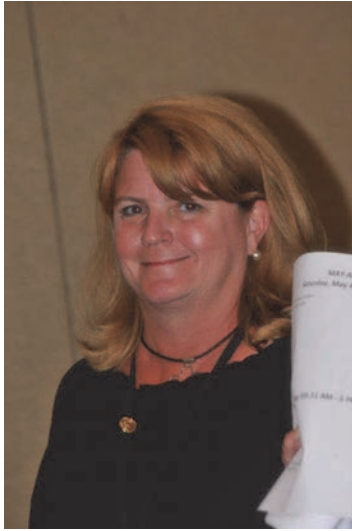
