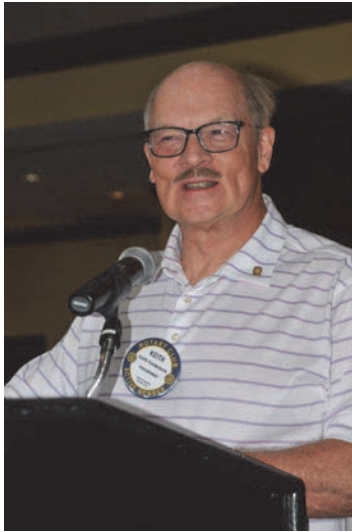

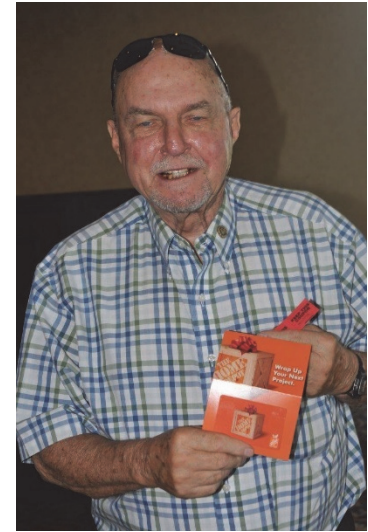
July 22 Meeting

Past President Rene Lanier announced the passing of **Gant Adams** – a Past President of the Rotary Club Vinings and past ADG.



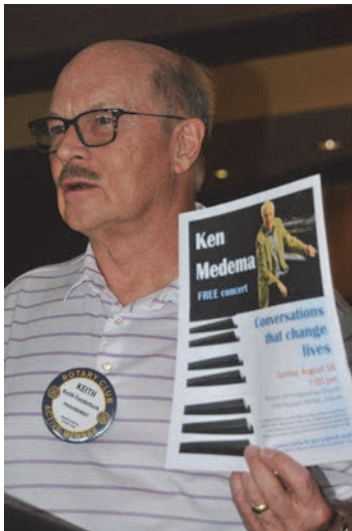
