**President Keith Funderburk** presided over the meeting.



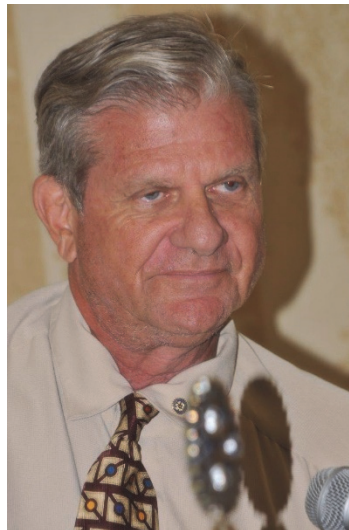
**Bob Wall** conducted the invocation, led the club in the Pledge of Allegiance and Four Way Test and gave a Meet Your Rotarian talk.



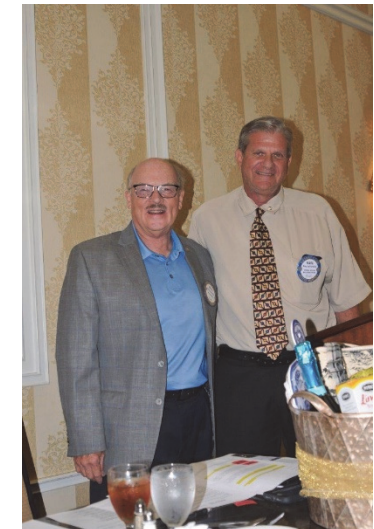
**Brenda Erickson** selected the winning raffle ticket.
