She is a certified trainer for QPR (Question, Persuade, and Refer) for suicide prevention and Youth Mental Health First Aid and is an advocate for youth and families on personal, county and state levels.

Dr Agatston is co-author of the book, *Cyberbullying: Bullying in the Digital Age* with Robin Kowalski, Ph.D., and Susan Limber, Ph.D. and has co-authored a chapter for the book, *Expert Perspectives in Cyberbullying* as well as a chapter for the book *Media Violence and Children*. She is also co-author of the *Cyberbullying Curriculum for Grades 6 – 12 and the Cyberbullying Prevention Curriculum for Grades 3 - 5*. She has appeared on CNN as well as other local and national radio and television programs to discuss cyberbullying and other youth online risky behavior. She was a participant in the CDC’s Expert Panel on Electronic Media and Youth Violence, and the CDC’s Expert Panel on Youth Involvement in Bullying and Suicide-Related Behaviors. She has presented nationally and internationally on bullying, cyberbullying, and restorative practices.

Dr. Agatston is a Licensed Professional Counselor and the Coordinator of Crisis Response for the Cobb County School District. She was President for the International Bullying Prevention Association from 2015-2018 and serves on the Board for the Net Safety Collaborative.

David Hunter conducted the invocation, led the club in the Pledge of Allegiance and Four Way Test and did a Meet Your Rotarian talk.



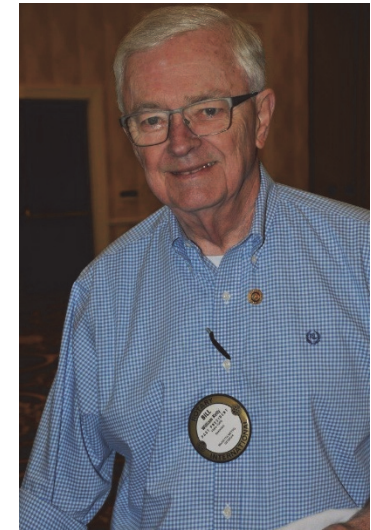
President Keith Funderburk drew the winning raffle ticket.

Johnny Fulmer conducted the Carithers Scholarship raffle and introduced guests.



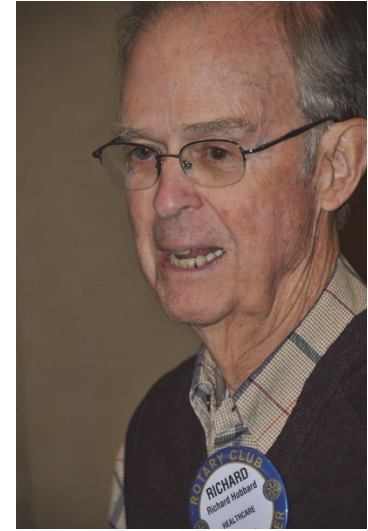
Bill Kelly won a git basket from Church Street Market in the Carithers Scholarship raffle.



Amy Erskine announced the perfect attendance drawing.



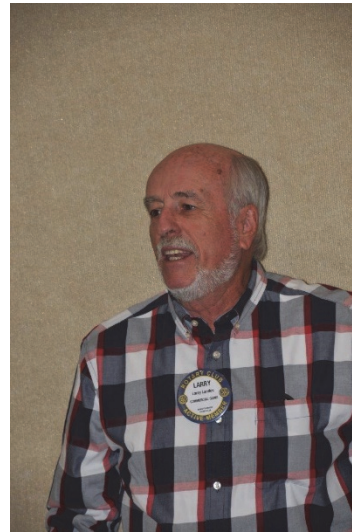
Past President K.C. Kadow gave sunshine for the club's support during his father's recent passing.



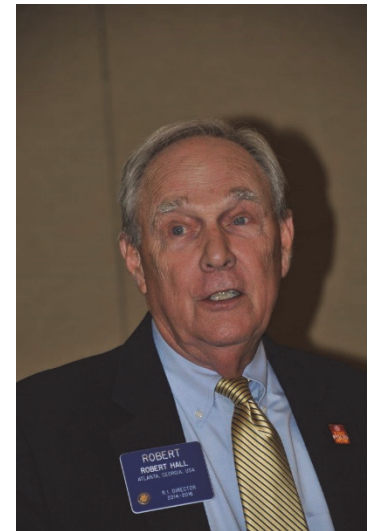
Richard Hubbard gave sunshine for a recent trip to New Mexico.

Buck Buchanan stated the club was conducting a Paul Harris Fellow Society drive.



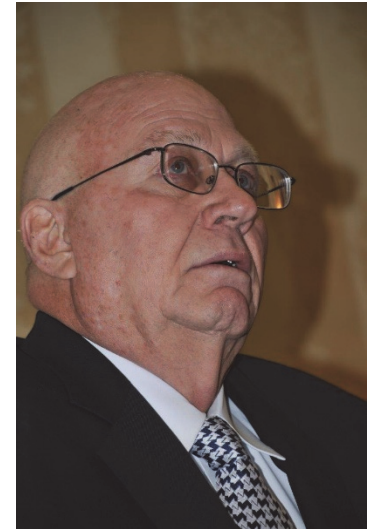
Past President Bill White introduced the day's speaker.
