14 inch chainsaw for branches

2 18-inch chainsaw, or 1, 18" and 1, 20" chainsaw (20inch will have more torque but heavier)

24-inch chain saw

Pole saw

Safety Gear Chaps, Hard hat with face shield. **For each saw.**

Extra chains and spark plugs

Chain sharpening set.

Gas and bar oil

Large wedge and small wedges Plastic one's work and wont tear a chain up if you hit it.

Log jack

Medium to large Bolt cutter (cutting metal cables and powerline tangled in debris)

Small hand-held sledge Hammer

Large sledge hammer

2-4-rakes

Wheelbarrow, trash cans with wheels or sled for debris. Wheel barrel doesnt store well, takes up a lot of space

1 Large & 2 small first aid kits (\$200), Make sure you have a blot clotting pack on trailer in case of bad Cuts!

5 - 5-gallon Gas cans

20- Sawyer Family water filters , (10 min)

1 - 150-gallon Heavy duty food bladder for water storage if needed and folds up good for storage.

1 - 30-gallon food grade Water bladders or 3, 5 gallon food grade water cans

10-Tarps 10 x 10s and larger up to 20 x 20

12-Pairs of work gloves, 12 safety Glasses 30 KN 95 masks

2 Half face respirator with extra filters,

2-4-foldable army cots (used for teams if needed, many times first few nights can be spent in parking lots)

2 - 2500 watts to 5000 watts Generators (usually a trailer will have 1 smaller and 1 larger generator)

2- floor Fans or pancake, fans 2 box fans

Medium size dehumidifier if Muck and gutting is in your area of disasters. (many times we have 2nd team bring these in)

10 x10 Folding canopy

1 -48-quart) Ice chest

1-(100 quart) Ice chest

2 - 50-foot Extension cords

2 LuminAID 2 in 1 solar lights (also charges cell phones)

2 - Surge protected power strips

1 -2-burner multi fuel stove for cooking meals for team if you half to be self sufficient.

5-7Day food supply for 4-men (\$150) Dry storage food. These are for emergency. Usually stock up on real food before deployment.

Small cheap 4 man tent. (many times we just put up canopy and mosquito next and cots)

Mountain House Foods, dehydrated long storage

Hand tools

Pry bars, Hammers, Screwdriver set, Channel grip plyers, Wrench, and socket set. 3 ton floor jack, square shovels, large debris shovel (looks like a snow shovel), push brooms, Utility knives (10)

Power tools Battery and plug

- A good kit is the DeWalt 7 tool kit: 7 Cordless tools: drill/driver, impact driver, circular saw, work light, reciprocating saw, oscillating multi-tool, and grinder
- 20V MAX system: Maximum initial battery voltage (measured without a workload) is 20 volts. Nominal voltage is 18
- Comes with two 2Ah lithium-ion batteries, a charger, a large rolling contractor tool bag for convenience a

2 saws-all, extra batteries and chargers are a good idea

1-2 Spare tires for trailer. (Tire repair kit) Fix a Flat, or the green slime foam to stop leaks) You will get a flat in the disaster zone at some time. **My trailer has 2 spares now.**

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
