We honored the DeKalb Neighborhood Enforcement Team (NET). The team consists of 7 police officers, both men and women. Their experience is drawn from a variety of expertise from within the department and beyond ranging from uniformed patrol, SWAT, major felon detectives and ex-military personnel. Each member of the unit is responsible for making the community safer. Often these officers go undercover into high crime areas to help enhance the life of the residents caught in these areas. The crimes these officers are dealing with range from petty thefts to murder. The NET is responsible for arresting 457 offenders in 2016 for violating state or county ordinances. Ninety-five of those cases were felony cases including murders, burglaries, aggravated assaults and armed robbery. The remaining 342 of those cases were theft, prostitution, and disorderly conduct. The team has also seized 20 guns in the process of protecting and serving DeKalb County. The Rotary Club of Tucker thanks these brave men and women for their public service.
