The Rotary Club of Tucker welcomes Frank Auman, Mayor of the City of Tucker. Mayor Auman indicated that the City of Tucker was founded because the citizens thought they could govern themselves better than a governing body at a distance. The City has begun its governing process in three areas: Code Enforcement, Land Use and Planning, and Parks and Recreation. Code Enforcement is the first service put in place. Two officers are hired and the City is in the process of forming a court to enforce violations. Planning and Land Use hearings are now heard and permitted in Tucker. The area of Parks and Recreation is the last area to be developed. There are eleven parks and three dams in the City in various degrees of disrepair, and a plan is being developed to address these issues. The Mayor reports that the City is fully staffed now, and the budget has been passed. Public meetings are now being planned for community input on the Tucker Community Plan—"Tucker Tomorrow." Mayor Auman looks forward to a progressive 2017.
