**Reverend Raymond Coffman** selected the winning raffle ticket.



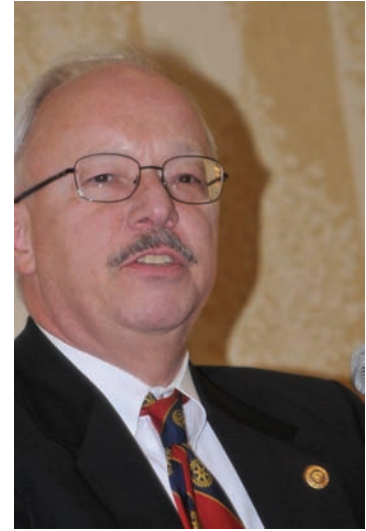
**Past District Governor Roy Strickland** visited with the club.
