Rotary International History

Rotary International has over 1.2 million members worldwide with 34,000 clubs located in 200 countries. Much of our international work is funded through The Rotary Foundation, which has the highest rating, 4 stars from Charity Navigator. Rotary is most known for its mission to eradicate Polio worldwide. With partners such as the Bill and Malinda Gates Foundation, Rotary has reduced polio cases by 99.9 percent. As of July 1, 2017, there are only 8 cases of polio in the world. To reach polio free status, it requires at least three years with no new polio cases.

Rotary Club of Newnan, GA, was chartered on February 29, 1924. Our membership consists of a diverse group of men and women who work, live, and volunteer in the Newnan-Coweta Community. Through leadership, local and international service projects, we work to make a difference in the lives of our community that we live and work in and our neighbors around the world. This year, we will be celebrating our 100th year of service.

What We Do

The Rotary Club of Newnan provides service to our community through specific projects that include The City of Newnan July 4th Fireworks celebration, packing days for Backpack Buddies, Toiletry Kits for The Samaritan Clinic, The Newnan High School Interact Club, Meals on Wheels delivery, our Honoring the Fallen Crosses at Memorial Day, and The Rotary Cup Scholarship Program for our three public high schools and three private high schools in our community. Each Year our club has the opportunity to apply for grant funds from Rotary International in the form of a Community Grant. Our past projects for this grant include Ruth Hill outdoor reading area and Music and Memory at our local nursing homes to help those with memory issues. This year, we will be creating and setting up a toiletry closet at our local mental health facility that will assist adults transitioning back into the workforce.
