Over 218 days, he pedaled 4,600 miles across 26 states – he started on his 55th birthday in March and ended up riding into Portland ME on October 14th, 2017. Along the way, Rick also met over 1,200 other people – he often asked strangers, “guess where I just rode my bike from...” which led to a lot of cool conversations and a lot of random acts of kindness too.
