Shari Martin of the Cobb Community Foundation selected the winning raffle ticket.



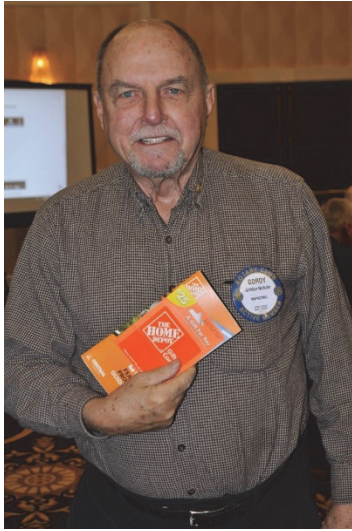
President-elect Keith Funderburk, Mitch Simmons and **Mike Bottema** greeted members and guests.

Past President Rosemary Martin won a Home Depot gift card in the Carithers Scholarship raffle.

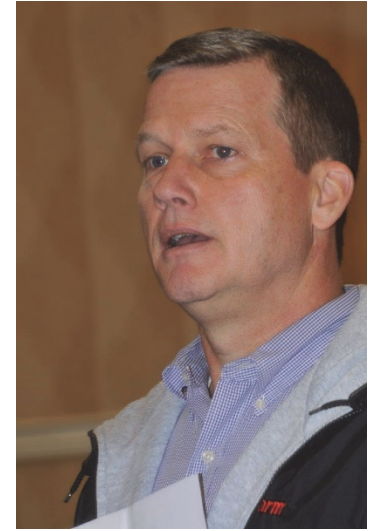
